Code of Conduct

This code of conduct covers behavior for any ARRCA marshal at any race track or related function where they are present as an ARRCA representative no matter what the track status is.

The day ends for any marshal who has imbibed alcohol or consumed any mind altering drug-legal or not.

All members are to be treated with respect and dignity.

Verbal and or physical abuse towards any person(s) will not be tolerated.

While on social media avoid writing anything that would embarrass ARRCA or compromise your ability to do your job. Even if you use privacy tools (determining who can view your page or profile, for instance, assume that everything you write, exchange or receive on social media is public).

You should never be on social media or on your phone while the track is hot.

There will be consequences for behavior unfitting a marshal.

Complaints have been brought to the board, who will make all final decisions.

A first offense will result in a warning.

Second offenses will result in suspension from the club for a period of time determined by the board.

If the complaint is against a board member that person will not be involved in any decision resulting from that complaint.

The board reserves the right to adjust the punishment if required.
